How to get there:

#### From Fiumicino Airport to Roma Termini train station:

- No-stop train *Leonardo Express*: departures every 30 minutes from Fiumicino Airport to Roma Termini Station. Ticket costs € 14,00 one-way. The trip takes 31 minutes.

#### From Roma Termini train station to Perugia Fontivegge Station

Take, from Termini station, regional or intercity train to Perugia Fontivegge station. Please check the departure platform and the exact time of departure in the scoreboards at the station. Train changes are planned in Foligno or Terontola-Cortona stations depending on the train you'll choose. Ticket prices from 12€ per person one-way.

The WP 4 includes the activities aimed to describe, within the limits of the European common perimeter shared by the partners during WP 2, the learning outcomes (knowledge, skills and competences) that characterise the professional figures which operate in the sector of health tourism, as well as to attribute the ECVET points to the same one and to the individual learning outcomes units.

WP 4, starting with 3<sup>rd</sup> Health Tourism Meeting in Perugia, will have a duration of 5 months, till the 4<sup>th</sup> Health tourism Meeting in Satu Mare (Romania), which will be held in November 2013.

The WP 4 will allow the production of 1 deliverable: the "Design of European professional figures in health tourism", that is a document containing the design of qualifications in terms of activities, tasks, knowledge, skills, competences, certification objectives, units of learning outcomes and related ECVET credit points, focusing on standard elements in all partner Countries (vocational profile, skill specifications, certification objectives), on subsidiary factors (certification ways; formal, non-formal and informal learning validation; procedures, qualification bodies), and on ECVET credit points allocation to learning outcomes units. The design of qualifications will be presented and validated during the Meeting in Satu Mare(Romania).
